

# myData Tools: Hospital/ED Utilization

With data from the Health Information Exchange, you can receive actionable and valuable insights on your patients admitted to a hospital or visited an ED within our application, myData.



**myData** is an innovative application that allows users to easily access and understand their patient profiles, identify gaps in care, and see how they rank in quality measures.

## What's included in the myData Hospital ED Utilization Dashboard?

View information on your patients who have visited an ED, been admitted to a hospital, had an inpatient readmission, or return to an ED days after discharge.

**Information on hospital visits include:** planned visits, unplanned visits, and direct hospital

**Information on ED visits include:** elective, urgent care visits, and unexpected visits

## What can you do with this information?

### Filter and review patient lists

Manage your patients using filters that provide:

- + Return to Hospital
- + Admission Type
- + Age Range
- + Gender
- + Race

### Follow-up after Emergency Department visit for people with high-risk multiple chronic conditions.

Assess ED visits for patients 18 years of age and older who have multiple high-risk chronic conditions and who had a follow-up service within seven days of an ED visit.

### Plan All-Cause Readmissions (PCR)

Assess the rate of adult acute inpatient stays, followed by unplanned acute readmission for any diagnosis within 30 days after discharge.

### Transition of Care (TRC)

Assess vital points of transition for Medicare beneficiaries 18 years of age and older after discharge from an inpatient facility. Four rates are reported:

- + Notification of Inpatient Admission
- + Receipt of Discharge Information
- + Patient Engagement after Inpatient Discharge
- + Medication Reconciliation Post-Discharge
